NOTICE

1. Chittaranjan Locomotive Works/Chittaranjan under the Ministry of Railways, Government of India desires to re-engage one retired JE/Mech for the Shop No.52 (Tool Room)/CLW/CRJ for a period up to 01.12.2019 or attaining the age of 65 years or till availability or the regularly selected candidate whichever is the earliest, on the terms & Conditions stipulated under Para (2) below:-

Sl.No	Category	Number of Vacancies	Medical Classification	Rate of monthly Remuneration
1.	JE/Mech	01	C1	Monthly remuneration of the retired employee being re-engaged shall be determined by reducing the pension from his last pay drawn (i.e basic Pay & DA)

The daily rate of the deduction (per day) from the monthly remuneration will be applicable on pro-rate basis to the re-engaged retired employee in the event of absence/not attending the duty.

2. The detail terms & conditions as applicable for re-engagement of the retired Railway employee are furnished below:

i) The retired employees covered under the safety Related Retirement Scheme/Liberalised Active Retirement Scheme for Guaranteed Employment for Safety staff (LARSGESS) are not eligible for re-engagement.

ii) The Re-engaged employees would be on full time re-engagement basis, as per the monthly remuneration indicated in Para-1, for a period up to 01.12.2019 or attaining the age of 65 years or till the vacant posts are filled up by regularly selected promotion/RRB candidates, whichever is earlier.

iii) All the candidates should have good physical, sound mental conditions as per Railway Medical Standards. They will be subjected to medical examination as per extant Railway rules and those who are found fit in the prescribed medical classification will be re-engaged.

iv) Retired staff re-engaged in the Railways will not have any claim or right for his/her continuity in service or automatic extension of the period of re-engagement. These Services will be terminated at the end of the engagement period.

v) The Railway administration will be at liberty to terminate the re-engaged retired employees by giving 15 days notice at any time during the re-engagement period without assigning any reason whatsoever. The services of the retired employees shall also be terminated forthwith, if he/she/they/it/are found to be mentally or physically incapacitated.

vi) In case of unsatisfactory work or misconduct on the part of the personnel so re-engaged, Railway reserves the right to terminate the engagement at any time without assigning any reason.

vii) The Retired staff are personally responsible for payment of professional tax, income tax and other duties/taxes levied by the state/Central Government from time to time.

viii) The detail instructions regarding duties and responsibilities, while on execution of Re-engagement agreement with Railway Administration, shall be given to the selected Retired staff along with offer of engagement.


xi) The Railway Administration reserves the right to cancel, amend or otherwise modify all or any of the terms of this notification without assigning any reason(s) thereto.

x) The suitability and competency of staff shall be adjudged before such re-engagement and the issue of their safety record as well as safety and other operational requirements as needed are adequately addressed.

Eligible and Wiling retired staff may submit their application in the prescribed format annexed with the notification, along with two recent passport size photographs (one to be affixed on the application form) and self attested Xerox copy of Service Certificate cum Pensioner's Identity Card, Pension Payment Order, Aadhaar Card etc. **Last date for submission of application is on 27.9.2019** No application will be entertained after the closing date.


