Sub:- Award of grant from SBF towards Technical Scholarship and Bidhan Lokmanya Scholarship for the financial year 2019-20

1. It is proposed to award technical scholarships and Bidhan Lokmanya Scholarships to the non gazetted employees in Substantive Grade Pay above Rs 2400/- as per 6th CPC i.e from level 5 onwards of 7th CPC as on 01.04.2019 ,to assist their meritorious and deserving children for the prosecution of Technical/Professional education during the financial year 2019-20.

2. . Technical Scholarship:-

15 (Fifteen) New scholarships are proposed to be given alongwith the renewal of scholarships awarded in earlier years to enable the students to continue /complete the course of study .Out of these 15 (Fifteen) New scholarships,02 (Two) scholarship are reserved for scheduled caste and 1(One) for scheduled Tribe . Amount of scholarship is Rs 1500/- per month.

3. . Bidhan-Lokmanya Scholarship:-

15 (Fifteen) New scholarships are proposed to be given along with the renewal of scholarships awarded in earlier years to enable the students to continue /complete the course of study .Out of these 15(Fifteen) New scholarships ,Two (02) scholarships are served for scheduled caste and 01(One for scheduled Tribe. Amount of scholarship is Rs 750/- per month.

4. Staff may also apply in favour of their brothers /sisters who are wholly dependent on them enclosing authentic proof to show that they are wholly dependent on the employees.
5. The SC/ST candidates should submit certificate from DM/SDO alongwith their applications to show that they belong to the reserved category .In the event of applications of SC/ST staff not coming in the reserved quota ,the scholarship would be allotted to the other deserving candidates .
6. Detailed rules regulating award of technical/Bidhan Lokmanya scholarships are attached herewith .Payment of scholarship will be made through the bank account of the scholar child .




7. **Last Date:-** Application both for award of new scholarship as well as for renewal of scholarship ,duly filled in prescribed form and supported with required relevant certificate/ documents may be submitted through the concerned Head of department ,so as to reach AWO & Secy./SBFMC by 13.01. 2020 .No application will be entertained after 13.01.2020.
9. **One time scholarship during 2019-20:-** Application of the staff which have not been considered for award of technical/Bidhan Lokmanya Scholarships during the financial year 2019-20 will be considered for one time **Technical /Bidhan Lokmanya Scholarship @ Rs 4500/- per annum** for the financial year 2019-20 depending upon availability of fund and as per the marks obtained in HS/Secondary/Diploma examination .

RULES FOR TECHNICAL /BIDHAN LOKMANYA SCHOLARSHIP

1.The scholarships will be available for son & daughters ,dependent brothers & sisters of non gazetted employees in **Substantive Grade Pay above Rs 2400/- as per 6th CPC i.e from level 5 onwards of 7th CPC as on 01.04.2019**

2.The following priority have been laid down for awarding Technical Scholarships:-

(i)Highest priority to be given to applicants studying for MCA,MBA & Post Graduate Technical/Professional Courses recognized by eminent Universities (Two yrs) degree course in medicine including Homeopathy and Ayurveda System of Medicine ,Pharmacy and Various Branches of Engineering ,Computer Science, Architecture and Environment Planning ,Bachelor of Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry, B.Sc (Agriculture) , C.A. , ICWA, B.Ed.

(ii) Second priority for diploma course in Medicine including Homeopathy ,Ayurveda System of Medicine ,Pharmacy and Engineering ,Computer Science, Architecture and Environment Planning .

(iii) Third priority to be given to applicants studying for degree course in Pure sciences ,if the quota of scholarships is not fully availed of by categories i & ii above.

NB:- Training in the traineeship Duffering Marine engineering Course conducted by the directorate Engineering Marine training under the ministry of transport will be considered as an Engineering course for the purpose of grant of award of technical scholarships to the Railway employees children only.

Selection criteria will be based as follows :-

Scholarship for post graduate and degree courses will be disbursed as per merit position prepared on the basis of marks obtained in 10+ 2 examination or diploma examination when the student ward does not pursue (10+2) examination .Scholarship for diploma courses will be disbursed as per merit position prepared on the basis of marks obtained in Secondary examination .The percentage of marks will be calculated taking into account the marks obtained in all the subjects appearing at the mark sheet.

5. The courses offered by Open Universites /Institutions through correspondence are not eligible for scholarship.

4.The scholarship will be payable from the date of admission into a particular institute or class from which Technical education or date of award as the case may be up to the completion of degree course on the basis of Scholastic record of the student .

5.The employees who are awarded scholarships for their sons/daughters/dependent brothers/sisters in the previous year desiring continuance of the same ,should also apply for renewal in the prescribed proforma with declaration supported by certificates from the head of the institute to the effect that their children/dependent brothers /sisters are still prosecuting their studies for which scholarships were awarded previously and that they have passed the annual examination for the last scholastic years/ studying in a class higher than the one in which they studied in the previous year .


6. The technical scholarships granted to candidates may be continued, in cases where no failures or detention in the same class and the candidates is allowed to continue studies in the next higher class.

7. The Scholarships once granted will not be affected by the death, invalidation or retirement or superannuation of the employee .However, if any employee resigns from service, he will lose his scholarships sanctioned to his children or dependent brothers /sisters .

8. The amount of the scholarship will be paid as applicable.

9. Staff/students who are in receipt of any scholarships or assistance from any other source are not eligible for Technical scholarships. The application should be accompanied by a certificate from the institution where the ward is studying that the ward is not in receipt of any scholarship of financial assistance from the institution or from any other source.

10.If both the applicant and his /her wife/husband are Govt. employees ,the full particulars of income of the Husband/Wife of the applicant will have to be furnished .
